And many of them aren't just offering support – they're opening doors to companies looking specifically for leaders like you.

Don't stop there. Almost every State Employment Agency has boots-on-theground in the form of Local Veteran Employment Reps (LVERs). They'll help fine-tune your resume, line you up with veteran-friendly employers, and introduce you to additional allies like Staffmark Group, where military recruiting isn't a program – it's a commitment.
